



Dear Student Veterans and Dependents:

Greetings! You have completed your UNT Dallas admission application, the first step in the application process. There are a few additional steps that need to be completed before an admission decision is reached.

- Step 2: ACTIVATE your [MyUNTD](#) student portal account. Your student portal provides the most up to date information regarding admissions, financial aid and scholarships, and other pertinent information. An email was sent to the email address provided on your Apply Texas application with your EUID and PIN.
- Step 3:
 - Freshmen applicants: Submit official high school transcripts. They can be sent electronically by your high school to admissions@untdallas.edu. Our office can also receive electronic transcripts via several different transcript delivery systems. Students that have taken dual credit courses will also need to submit their college transcript.
 - Transfer applicants (students who earned college credit after graduating from high school): Submit official transcripts from all college and universities attended. Transcripts can be sent electronically from your college or university to admissions@untdallas.edu. Students transferring from Dallas College can request their electronic transcript by clicking [here](#).
 - Military coursework may be considered for transfer credit. This includes: Joint Service Transcript and Community College of the Air Force. The university uses the American Council on Education (ACE) guidelines when evaluating these transcripts. Keep in mind that military credit can satisfy degree requirements, but it is not factored into admission determination.

- Step 4: Complete and submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by visiting www.fafsa.ed.gov, if you are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen. UNT Dallas' FAFSA code is 042421. If you are not a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen but, graduated from a public or private high school in the state of Texas, please submit your completed Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) and submit directly to the

UNT Dallas' Office of Financial Aid. TASFA application can be found by visiting www.collegeforalltexas.com.

- **Step 5:** Review the [Veterans Success Center Resources](#) web page. Please complete the following tasks after registering for class:
 - Submit all required documents together to the Veterans Success Center after registering for class.
 - Fill out forms completely, incomplete forms or field left blank will cause a delay in processing. The Veteran Enrollment Certification Form can be found [here](#). This must be completed each semester to prevent any delays in payment.
 - Inform VA representative of any changes in enrollment, student status, or degree plan information.
 - Check your student email! Certification notifications are only sent to UNT Dallas student email accounts. Not sure how to activate your student email? Email admissions@untdallas.edu with your student ID number and date of birth.
 - Allow 7-10 business days after document submission before contacting VA for payment information.
